Extras (things above and beyond)..... I took a lot of time and pride in creating the graphics and design layout of my site. All of the graphics (not pictures) are self-made and I created some animated gifs to display the names of the different band members. I have over 30 pages of content. I implemented several examples of JavaScript rollovers to aid my design, a JavaScript pop-up window on the "wallpapers" page, and JavaScript scrolling text on the splash page. Finally, I added a few tables and a nested frameset in the "tours" page.

Problems in Netscape..... The site works almost perfect on Netscape 6. The only problems that I found when using this version of Netscape was that the size of my tables in the "tours" portion of the page was a little off. Also, the fade that is used on the navigation bar only works in IE (I knew this when I designed it though.) I was not able to test it in 5 but when testing the site on some older versions of Netscape in the PUCC labs (4.42 I think) I ran into some problems, for some reason it would say "not found" when I tried to load some of my links and a lot of graphics didn't show up at all, even though they show up fine in IE and Netscape 6. It is really weird because my splash page shows up perfect in the older version, but most of my other links, which use the same or a very similar code-layout, do not show up at all. I tried for awhile to figure out the problem but I couldn't and since it works perfect in Netscape 6 I just decided to leave it alone.
